

# Setup Guide

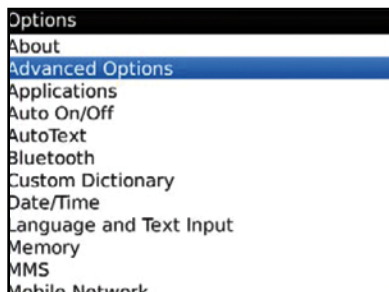
## Downloading and setting up Push to Talk on a BlackBerry device.

Follow the steps below to download, install, and enable the Push to Talk application on a BlackBerry® device.

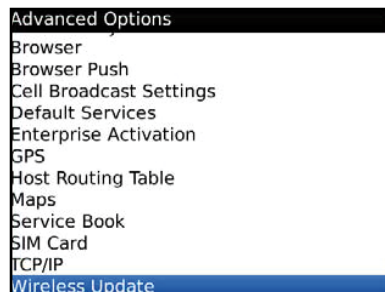
Before starting the download, ensure that your browser ID is set to BlackBerry. To verify your browser ID:

- From the browser, press the **Menu key**, select **Options**, select **Browser Configuration**, select **BlackBerry**, press the **Escape key**, and select **Save**.
- Press the **Menu key**, select **Options**, select **Cache Operations**, and select **Clear**.

**Note:** BlackBerry Bold™ users should begin with **Step 4**.



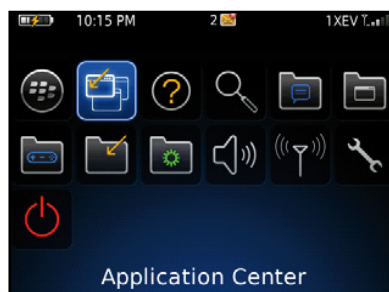
**Step 1:** BlackBerry Tour™ users should first check the device software. Version 5.0 or higher is needed for Push to Talk on BlackBerry. From the home screen, select **Options > Advanced Options**.



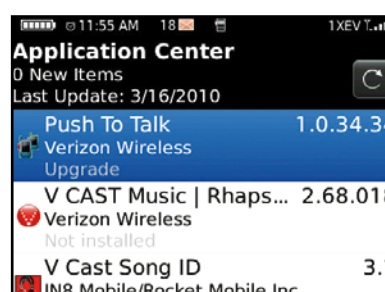
**Step 2:** Select **Wireless Update**.



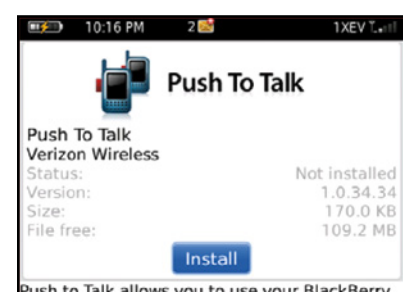
**Step 3:** If the wireless update process screen appears, select **Next** to continue. Once you confirm the software version, tap the end key to return to the home screen. Push to Talk requires BlackBerry software version 5.0.0 or higher.



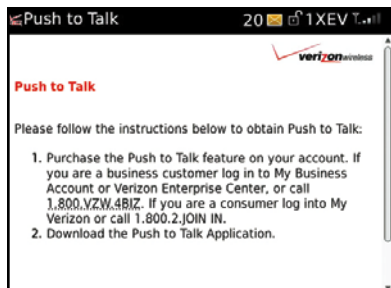
**Step 4:** From the home screen, scroll to find the Application Center. Select the **icon** to get the Push to Talk application.



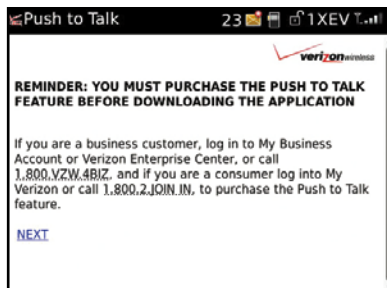
**Step 5:** In the Application Center, scroll to select the Push to Talk application. The BlackBerry browser will launch and offer an agreement statement. Scroll down to select **I agree**.



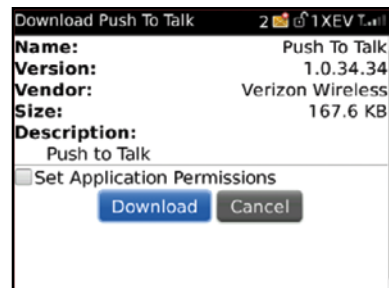
**Step 6:** Select **Install**.



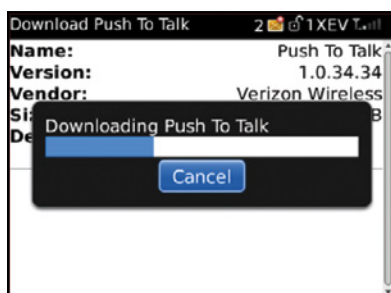
**Step 7:** Two Push to Talk feature validation screens appear. Confirm that the account has the Push to Talk feature while the customer reviews the screens. Scroll down and select **Next**.



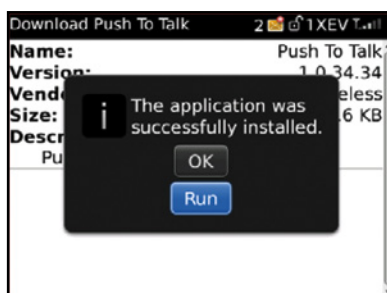
**Step 8:** Select **Yes** to continue.



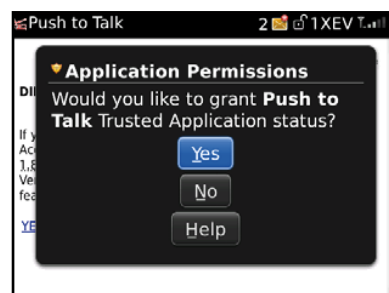
**Step 9:** Select **Download** to begin the Push to Talk application download.



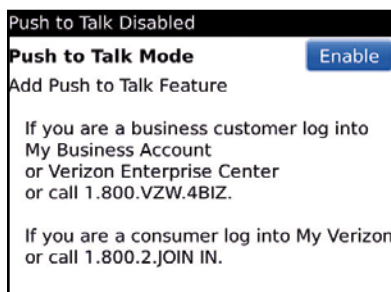
**Step 10:** The install process will start.



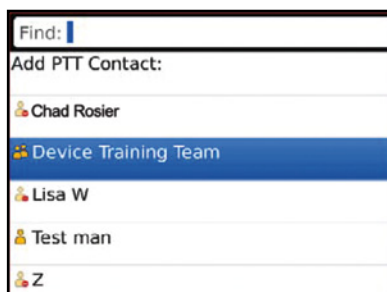
**Step 11:** The download will complete and prompt the user to select **OK** or **Run**. Select **Run**.



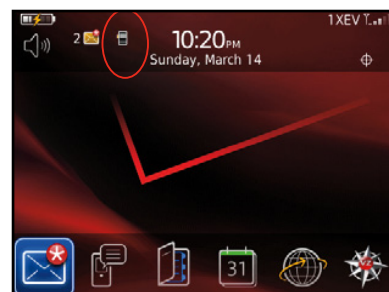
**Step 12:** Select **Yes** to add as a trusted application.



**Step 13:** The Push to Talk application is now enhanced so that Push to Talk mode can be enabled or disabled from the application itself.



**Step 14:** Pressing the left-side key should bring up the Push to Talk application and any contacts associated with the device, which allows the user quick and easy connection to the contact.



Notice the Push to Talk icon in the upper information bar to the left of the current time. This is a quick way to ensure the Push to Talk application has been enabled.
